

Fellow Riders,

We are wrapping up the 2011 TRh Family Enduro Series with the awards ceremony on January 28th, 2012 at Skull Creek. Please come on out for this event, we will have burgers and hot dogs for lunch and distribute the awards by 1pm. After that, you will be able to get to ride the property all day. It's sure to be fun for the whole family!

I've been listening to all of your comments over the past year and will try to implement a few of those ideas into the 2012 Series Rules. Expect a few changes in the series for next year:

1. We have a new scoring system for the 2012 season! We will be using the MotoTally scoring system this year. Our goal is to deliver accurate results quickly after each race and have the race results posted in a day or two online.
2. We are going to a 20 point scoring system to help eliminate ties and it will also help the newer riders with their positions in the series. Our 10 point system left a lot to be desired. It didn't point anyone under 10th place and I think those riders (especially the newer ones) should have something to show for their efforts.
3. We will add another class to the series . Women's Advanced. They will ride the same course as the Mens' classes (long loops) and it should be pretty competitive. The longer course will be a little more challenging but will be a lot more fun! I've talked to a few ladies and they are excited about it! This new class will also help some of the younger girls bring a trophy home in the original Womens class because they won't have to compete with the more experienced women riders. We'll award the first 3 places in the advanced womens class.
4. Gator Bait Enduro- It's ON!!!! We are going to bring back the Gator Bait enduro out at Skull Creek for next year on April 21-22, 2012. Lynn Bailey has everyone stoked for this event and it is sure to be a show stopper. Please show him your support for the upcoming Gator Bait event!
5. We will keep the Grumpy old men 45+ for next year and will trophy 1st place only. The only other change will be the starting row. We'll move them ahead of the Juniors, Beginners and Womens Advanced.
6. We have 6 events scheduled this year and we are working hard to have a few of those at other properties. We hope to have a restart enduro at the Forest. The dates are posted and locations will follow.
7. We are always looking for people to chair a race. If you chair a race, you will not only get your race average, but will be awarded (3) additional race points. You need to sign up early to chair a race as I expect these positions to go fast. Schedule to follow soon.
8. Race workers will be in for a pleasant surprise. We will implement a worker raffle at each event. If you work, you get to drop your name in the hat and the lucky winner will get a prize. We are considering prizes such as full graphics kits, tires, bike stands, etc. I am still working out the details but you can bet that it will be a coveted prize to show the clubs appreciation.
