

TRH SKULL CREEK CYCLE PARK RULES

The following rules and regulations have been adopted by the TRH Skull Cree Cycle Park. Each member shall be required to review these rules with their family members and guests with a complete understanding of the following:

1. Membership will be limited to 150 qualified members.
2. A membership is non-refundable or transferable. For each annual Skull Creek membership fee, a portion goes towards a TRH membership and the balance goes towards leasing, maintaining and improving the TRH Skull Creek Cycle Park facility. New member's fees include a onetime \$15 administrative fee. Membership includes adult member, spouse, unmarried children under age 18 or 23 ,if a full time college student.
3. Each member shall carry a membership card as proof of membership while on the property. Membership cards loaned out or duplicated shall result in immediate TRH Skull Creek Cycle Park membership termination.
4. The gate must be locked after entering and leaving the premises.
5. Due to insurance restrictions, 3 wheel ATV's are prohibited.
6. Children under 16 may only operate ATVs that are designed for their age group as recommended by the U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission.
 - Age 6 and older: Under 70cc
 - Age 12 and older: 70cc – 90cc
 - Age 16 and older: over 90cc
7. Helmets are required at all time while riding whether on a bike or an ATV.
8. For safety reasons pit riding is prohibited in the camping area. Campground access riding is limited to a speed of 5 mph and no access riding is permitted before 7:00 a.m. or after 10.00 p.m. unless through a TRH Skull Creek Cycle Park event.
9. Mufflers and silencers are required.
10. Do not cut standing trees for firewood. No fires allowed outside the campground. No fires allowed during a Colorado County burn ban. Replace the firewood you use from the log rack.
11. No Trash Service - take it home with you.
12. The depositing of RV holding tanks on park property is prohibited except at the authorized dumping station on the south side of the camping area.
13. All firearms and hunting is prohibited. Do not ride during hunting hours in November & December except in designated riding zone (East of mine operation & Skull Creek).
14. Guest policy: See TRH Skull Creek Cycle Park Guest Policy.
15. Parents should sign the Guest Release on behalf of their minor children. Minors not accompanied by their parents must have their parents or guardians sign the TRH Skull Creek Cycle Park release form or Guest Pass available on the TRH Website (www.trh-cycle.org). Member's minor children may not take people out as guests without their parents.
16. Workdays:
 - a) **ALL** TRH Skull Creek members are required to maintain the trail system.
 - b) Trail maintenance weekends will be scheduled in the Spring & Fall.
 - c) Each Skull Creek member should attend at least one of these and help with ONE TRH event held at Skull Creek. The other two (2) remaining work days required by TRH may be at Skull Creek or at a TRH event held elsewhere. The only exception is members who have paid for a non-working membership. Submit work vouchers to the Membership Chairman.
 - d) Everyone is expected to help keep the clubhouse & campground clean.
17. Membership Termination:
 - a) Reported and/or observed violation of these rules and regulations will be recorded and reviewed by the Park Committee and a letter will be sent to the member involved by the TRH Skull Creek Park Director.
 - b) Flagrant and uncorrected violations will be subject to the review by the TRH Board of Directors for possible membership termination. If required, a written termination notification will be sent to the violating member by the TRH President.
