

# Trail Riders of Houston – Skull Creek Family Fun Day

- When:** March 20, 2010
- Where:** Skull Creek (Altair, TX)
- What:** Non-timed event involving 4 loops with special scoring events after each loop (see below for details)
- Classes:** Class A) 0-9 years  
Class B) 10-15 years  
Class C) 16-25 years  
Class D) 26+
- Cost:** 1) Skull Creek Members – Free  
2) TRH Members - \$10 per rider  
3) Guests - \$10 per rider
- Details:** There will be two different loops; one morning loop for all young riders and beginners (of any age) and one afternoon course for advanced riders that want a challenge. The total estimated time for each loop will be 1 hour (4 – 15minute loops, including scoring). After each loop, each rider will choose a different scoring station where your results will be recorded, most points win (see below)! In the event of a tie, slowest ride time on Station #4 wins. This is not a timed event so if the scoring stations are full, just wait your turn. Be sure to pick a different scoring station after each loop, repeats won't be counted. Trophy's for classes "a" and "b", bragging rights for "c" and "d". There will be two way traffic at the start and finish of each loop so please slow down and watch for oncoming riders.

## **Morning Loop – Easy Course**

Class A – Start time @ 9:30am

Class B/Beginners – Start time @ 10:30am

## **Afternoon Loop – Hard Course**

Class C – Start time @ 1:00pm

Class D – Start time @ 2:00pm

### **Station #1 – Washer Toss**

3 Washers Allowed

In the hole = 5 points

On the board = 3 points

Hit the board = 1 point

### **Station #2 – Golf Shoes**

3 Golf Shoe Allowed

Top Rung = 5 points

Middle Rung = 3 point

Bottom Rung = 1 point

### **Station #3 – Horse Shoes**

2 Horse Shoes Allowed

Ringer = 7 points

W/in 1 shoe = 5 points

W/in 2 shoe = 3 point

### **Station #4 – Slow Ride**

> 30 seconds = 15 points

20-30 seconds = 8 points

10-20 seconds = 4 point
